**Dr. Kevin D. Jones, EDBA** is a technology executive, academic researcher, and military veteran with a multifaceted career spanning more than three decades across enterprise IT leadership, entrepreneurship, applied research, and higher education. He brings to the boardroom a generalist's blend of operating experience as a former CTO and Fortune 100 IT leader, doctoral-level empirical research training, current expertise in artificial intelligence literacy and AI governance, and a long track record of stakeholder leadership across corporate, nonprofit, academic, and community settings.

Dr. Jones honorably served in the United States Army in both the Middle East and Panama, earning the Expert Infantryman Badge and the Army Parachutist Badge while serving in the storied 10th Mountain Division at Ft. Drum, NY. After his active-duty service, he served as a squad leader in G Co. 143rd Airborne LRSP in Houston, TX, earning the rank of Sergeant. He then enrolled in the Prairie View A&M ROTC program and graduated as a Distinguished Graduate of the Advanced Officer Basic Course.

Dr. Jones holds a Bachelor of Science in Computer Engineering Technology from Prairie View A&M University, where he served as Student Government Association President and was initiated into Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. Demonstrating an early commitment to education and service, he raised over \$110,000 for college scholarships. He earned a Master of Business Administration from the International School of Management in Paris, France, and an Executive Doctor of Business Administration (EDBA) from the University of Houston, where his dissertation applied Q-methodology and mixed-methods empirical research to surface and quantify stakeholder perspectives on agrivoltaic systems in Texas - a methodology directly transferable to evaluating the societal and economic impact of emerging technologies, including AI. His active research interests span agrivoltaics (agriculture and solar energy production), education, and artificial intelligence.

Dr. Jones launched his corporate career at The Coca-Cola Company as an Information Systems Consultant and Desktop Lead supporting The Minute Maid Company, where he led teams of up to ten resources across the Lotus Notes intranet portal rollout, Y2K desktop and laptop mitigation, a company-wide network printer deployment, and the implementation and discovery phase of a \$35M revenue management project building deep familiarity with enterprise technology risk, vendor management, and large-scale program governance.

Dr. Jones founded TEMAC Solutions, Inc., a Houston-based consulting firm that served major clients including ABB Lummus Global, The Coca-Cola Company, Dynegy, Inc., and the Super Bowl Host Committee — delivering technology strategy, enterprise project management, and technical due diligence as a “CIO for hire.” As Chief Technology Officer and co-founder of Collegiate Zone, a venture-backed technology startup, he raised over \$1 million in seed capital, led development of the

company's flagship platform, and managed an internationally distributed team of 25 to build one of the largest public online repositories of college scholarships.

Dr. Jones is also a published author of technology books focused on the iPad platform in a business context, including "*Keynote 4 iPad*," "*iPad University*" and "*iOS 6 Revealed*." Keynote for iPad was awarded the highest sales in its category on the Apple iBookstore.

Dr. Jones currently serves as an Assistant Professor at Lone Star College in Houston, TX one of the largest community college systems in the U.S. (over 91K students) — where he develops and teaches courses in programming (Python, C++, C#), IT infrastructure, system analysis & design, and project management. He sits on the Lone Star College AI Curriculum Committee designing system-wide AI electives, and teaches AI courses including "Demystifying AI" and "AI Security & Privacy: The AI Black Box." He also serves as an Adjunct Professor at the University of Houston, teaching MIS and Agile IT Project Management at the Bauer School of Business and "AI Fundamentals for Government Leaders" at the Hobby School of Public Affairs.

Dr. Jones has served on the boards of INROADS, Inc., the Downtown Houston Association, and the Engineering Technology Advisory Board for Prairie View A&M University, and is a graduate of Center for Houston's Future and Project Blueprint – United Way Greater Houston. He is also a Certified Climbing Instructor for the Boy Scouts of America, has served as Scoutmaster and Committee Chair, and has mentored numerous Eagle Scouts — including his two sons.

Dr. Jones and his wife Regina are co-owners and founders of **Jones Land Ranch (JLR)** in East Texas, a 73-acre family operation that informs his research on agrivoltaics. Married more than 30 years, the Joneses are proud parents of two Eagle Scout sons: Kevin C. Jones (U.S. Army – Military Police) and Dylan Jones (Phi Theta Kappa Scholar, Sam Houston State University).
